Your MP's assistant will pick up. You can talk with them about your concerns and ask them to have your MP call you back.

Here is a sample of your side of the conversation:

"Hi, I'm [your name] and I am one of your constituents. I appreciate your service to our community [give an example if you can]. I'd like to talk about supporting Canada's prostitution legislation, outlined in the Protection of Communities and Exploited Persons Act (PCEPA). I support PCEPA's approach, which makes buying sex and third-party activities like recruiting illegal, while those who are being prostituted are not subject to criminal charges.

PCEPA has been reviewed and reported on by the Justice and Human Rights Committee. As the government considers how to move forward, this is a critical time to advocate for PCEPA to be upheld and enforced across the country. [Talk a little about why you care about keeping PCEPA]. What are your thoughts on this? Would you please support PCEPA and advocate for it to be enforced across Canada? Thank you for taking the time to talk with me today."
